OVERVIEW

Thank you for visiting thecommonroof.ca. As a guest to our site, your privacy is very important to us. Following are our online information practices and the way your information is collected and used at this site.

By your use of thecommonroof.ca you signify your acceptance to our privacy policy. If you do not agree to this privacy policy, you are not permitted to use this site. Amendments to this privacy policy will be posted at this URL and will become effective when posted. By your use of thecommonroof.ca following posted changes to this privacy policy, you signify your acceptance to those changes.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

This privacy policy governs use of the information that you provide to us. It does not govern the manner in which we may use information we have obtained from any other source, such as information obtained from public records.

There may be times when we ask you to provide certain personally identifiable information about yourself. For example, you may submit personal information, subscribe to services and/or express opinions on thecommonroof.ca through our ongoing member engagement activities (i.e., satisfaction surveys). The types of personally identifiable information that may be collected include your name, address, email address, telephone number, demographic information and information about your interests and behaviors. Whether or not you provide such information is completely your own choice.

thecommonroof.ca site may also collect certain non-personally identifiable information when you visit many of our web pages such as the type of operating system you are using (e.g., Windows, MacOS), the type of browser you are using (e.g., Chrome, Firefox) and the domain name of your Internet service provider (e.g., Shaw or Telus).

USE OF INFORMATION

In general, we will use the personally identifiable information you provide to us for the purpose for which such information was provided. We may also use this information to contact you when necessary; conduct trend analysis; and perform site administration. You may opt-out of receiving future mailings from thecommonroof.ca and other affiliated entities by following the instructions set forth in the opt-out section at the bottom of our emails.

We will not sell, share, or rent your email address to other parties in any way other than what is disclosed in this privacy policy.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, we reserve the right to disclose personally identifiable information in special cases when we believe that disclosing information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to or interference with our site, other users of our

site, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities, or where we are required to do so by court order or to enforce our rights. We reserve the right to disclose personally identifiable information when we in good faith believe that the law requires us to do so.

USE OF IP ADDRESSES

We may use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to otherwise administer our site.

COOKIES

To enhance your experience on thecommonroof.ca, some of our webpages may use “cookies.” Cookies are text files we place in your computer’s browser to store your preferences. Cookies, by themselves, do not tell us your email address or other personally identifiable information unless you choose to provide this information to us by. We use cookies to understand site usage and to improve the content and offerings on our site. For example, we may use cookies to personalize your experience at our web pages.

SECURITY

thecommonroof.ca has industry-standard security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information under our control. While there is no such thing as “perfect security” on the Internet, we will take reasonable steps to ensure the safety of your personal information.

If registration or any offer asks users to enter sensitive information, that information is encrypted and is protected with the industry-standard encryption software—SSL. While on a secure page, such as our order form, the lock icon on web browsers such as Firefox and Chrome display as locked.
